- Mia is donating a laptop to the boosters (treasurer). She will include QuickBooks.
- W9s will be available for donation purposes.
- Chris and Zach ordered some of the equipment gifted from the boosters. They will submit an invoice to Mia.

❖ Winter Guard Updates

- A Winter Guard Packet will be sent out this week.
- Mrs. Rigolini has added a Canvas classroom for participants.
- There are currently 8 students enrolled.
- Practices will take place virtually Mondays and Wednesdays at 5 pm.
- If in-person practices begin, WG may meet on Saturdays from 8-11 am. More info to follow.
- WG cost will be \$388, and can be paid through MySchoolBucks via the “School Store.”

❖ Open Floor Conversation

They need to complete a form (found in the counseling office), request that Chris or Zach sign off on the form request, and then "meet" with Dr. Page for approval. This is not a given, and students need to follow through to insure they are exempt from the PE requirement for graduation.
- Marching Band Info for 2021-2022 Season - CBA is restructuring and revamping their program. There is a tentative calendar posted on their website. Saturday events are currently scheduled, and we can participate if we choose to do so.
