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### **❖ Summary of Current Financials**

- Mia gave a finance report (see spreadsheet below).
- We made about \$700 from the King Soopers Loyalty Card Program for the 2020 year! As a reminder, you can attach your King Soopers loyalty card to the HRHS Band Booster account for us to receive 5% on all your purchases. No card to load, and no other number to give at checkout! To associate your loyalty card with the King Soopers Community Rewards Program, please visit <http://www.kingsoopers.com> and click on "Welcome, Sign In." Then click "Sign In" and sign in to your King Soopers account OR create a new account. Once signed in, click on "My Account" and then "My Account" again. This brings you to the Account Summary page. On the left side, click on "Community Rewards." Under "Find an Organization," search for HRHS and then click "Enroll" under **HRHS Band Boosters EA889**.
- Please also make "Highlands Ranch High School Band Boosters" your Amazon Smile supporting organization, and Amazon will send a portion of your purchases to the Band's general fund.

- There are still some families that have not paid for MB, WP and WG seasons. Chris and Zach will be sending individual emails to these families in the days to come.

- There is a competition each Saturday in March.
- She has reserved gym time each Monday during the month of March for students to practice.

#### ❖ Winter Percussion Update

- Gail will ask Zach about a WP uniform.
- As stated, some families have not paid the WP fee, so some line items of the budget cannot be purchased yet (uniforms for example). If you would like to split your fees into a couple months, please reach out to bookkeeper, Derek (Richard) Steffes. He can help set up partial payments for January and March.
- Sean will let us know when scheduling dates are confirmed.
- Rehearsals have been taking place in the auditorium and band room. Things are coming together well.
- RMPA recordings need to be submitted before the weekend. Therefore, the recordings will take place on Tuesdays and Thursdays during regular rehearsals (not on Saturdays).
- Hoping to participate in the second competition (end of the month).

#### ❖ Yearbook Pictures

- Amy Baum mentioned that this is usually the time that the yearbook committee reaches out and requests pictures. We have heard very little from the yearbook committee. August will reach out to the committee.

August will also put a folder of our 2020-2021 band photos together, and send them to the committee. *Follow up:* August reached out to point person, Emma Pulse. She has not assigned a team to the “Band Spread,” yet. Once she does, she will let us know. August will send her a folder of the pictures we already have. Ms. Pulse asked us to let her know of any upcoming events that her staff can attend and take pictures of. To be continued. Once we have dates for Spring Concert and Small Ensembles, we will let her know.

- Decision was made to table spirit wear at this point.
